## Program Description

Honouring Gifts is a community-based training program run by Ka Ni Kanichihk Inc.

Honouring Gifts aims to provide young Indigenous mothers with the tools and skills to further pursue education and employment.

Honouring Gifts will help you understand your career options, and support development of your skills through training, employment, or education. Participants will also have the opportunity to take part in a six-week unpaid work placement in their field of choice. Participants will also have the opportunity to receive a variety of certifications, like Food Handlers, First AID/CPR, & Manitoba Service Excellence.

Through setting and achieving goals, women may aspire to enter into the workforce or pursue continued education.

The Honouring Gifts Program runs yearly from September to June". We can provide support with finding Child care. Applications can be picked up from our office Monday – Friday 8:30 to 4:00 pm.
